Authority and Peace

Recently I was asked what my hobbies were. It was hard to answer. If I had a little extra time and money, I'd like to plant an herb garden but I don't and so that can't be my hobby yet. When I have tried to plant a garden, I haven't had the daily time to take care of it. So, my hobby is mostly doing what needs to be done and then being too tired to do the rest that didn't get done.

That being said, I noticed that when I had a minute the other day, I turned on the show Supernanny and sat down on the couch. She comes into a family that's chaotic and disrespectful and lost in life. She tells the parents how to take authority over their own home. It seems like a given that parents would have authority in their house. Yet in today's world it's become a scarcity.

I began to think about that and I realized most parents don't believe they should have authority over their children because they don't believe there should be any authority over them. Everybody should get to decide for themselves what they want and have it. So, when they have several children who want different things and they cannot fulfill every desire the parents feel like they have failed. The kids believe the parents have failed and that they have a right to act out because of it. This is not the way that God intended us to live, chasing fleshly desires and wants. He gave us the truth so that we have a standard to judge our desires. He says that children should honor their mothers and fathers. He says that wives should submit their wills to their husbands. And that husbands should lay down their lives for their wives. Just as Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. God holds authority over all the Earth. Everything in it is his and belongs to him, it is he who made it.
